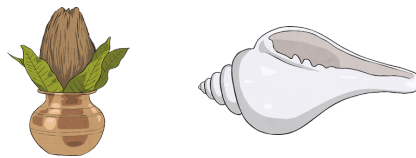
Some symbols are images.



Some symbols are physical acts completed by people.

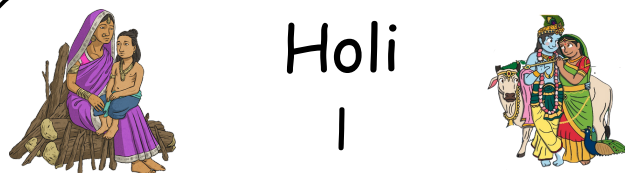


Some symbols are physical objects used in worship.
