Ibrahim and other prophets

Ibrahim, known as Abraham in Judaism and Christianity, is an important person in each of the three religions.

The three religions are called Abrahamic religions.



Ibrahim had many descendants who became prophets (messengers).

Muhammad (PBUH) was a prophet and is seen as the founder of Islam.

Calendar

Based on the lunar calendar, each month begins when a new moon is seen in the sky.



Ramadan

Ninth month of the Islamic lunar calendar.



A chance to ask for forgiveness and pray for direction.

Muslims fast during daylight hours.



At the end of Ramadan is a celebration called 'Eid-ul-Fitr' meaning 'breaking the fast'.

Mosque

Islamic place of worship



Prayer mats are used when praying.

Worshippers face the Quibla wall ensuring they are facing Mecca.



Shoes must be removed

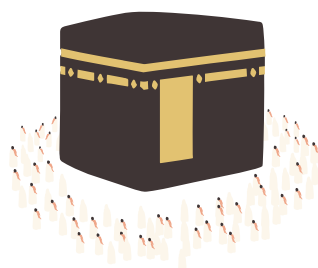


The Qur'an, the holy text is placed on a special stand.

One of the Five Pillars of Islam.

Annual pilgrimage to Mecca. A holy city for Muslims.

Prayer

Wudu is performed before prayer.

Mosques have a special area for wudu to be performed.
