Can trace its origins to over 3500 years ago.

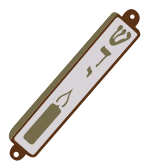
Jewish people believe Abraham made a covenant (deal) with God

Remembers Moses saving the Israelites

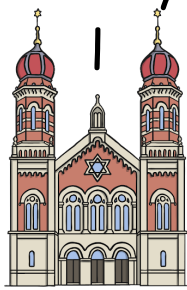
Seder plate is used.

Worship can happen at home or in a Synagogue.



A special area called the Ark is where the Torah scrolls are kept.



Hanukkah

Festival of Lights

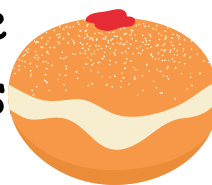
Celebrates the Maccabee Brothers and the miracle that happened.

Oil stayed lit for 8 days instead of 1 so they could fix the temple.



Celebrated over 8 nights.

Foods made from oil are eaten, like doughnuts



Candles are lit each night of the festival.



Dreidel is played.

Written in Hebrew



Some of the stories are also found in the Bible

Treated with respect.

Yad is used to read the scrolls.



Shavuot

Harvest Festival

Remembers Moses being given the Torah.



Shabbat

Sabbath day - 7th day of the week.

'To rest'

Remembers the creation story.
