Humanist celebrations have no link to religion.

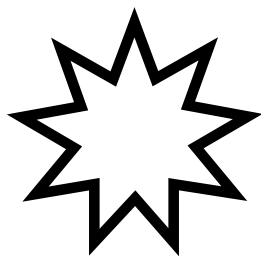
Ceremonies are to celebrate important events with
