persons sins.



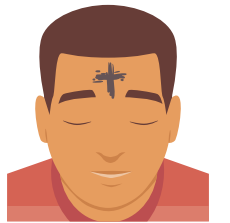
Someone who is baptised

ashes on their forehead.

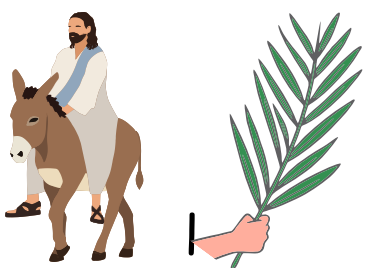


Holy Week

sharing the wine.

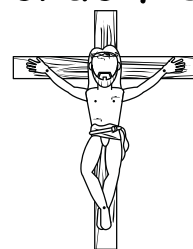
Jesus told the
