Born a Hindu over 500 years ago

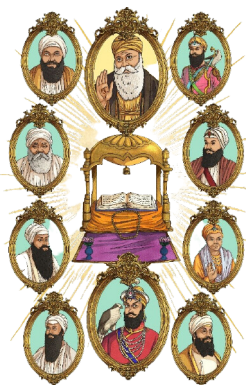

A festival celebrating harvest and Sikh New Year.

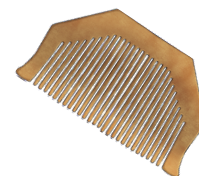
Guru Gobind Singh created the Khalsa during a Vaisakhi celebration.
