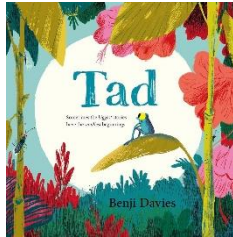


What are we learning in Reception this week?

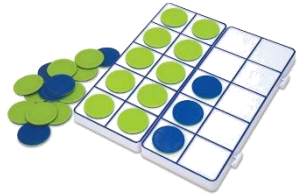
We are reviewing all our Spring Tricky words!
