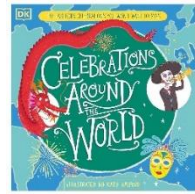


# What are we learning in Reception this week?

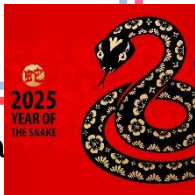
## 1 2 3 Mathematics

Comparison and subitising.

We will be developing our language of comparison through measures. We will reinforce the ability to subitise.

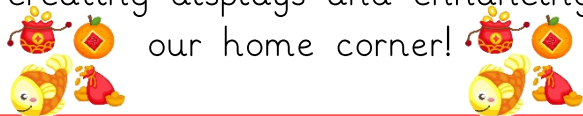
Counting is one tool that can be used for addition and subtraction calculations.

Include zero (or nought) regularly as a value.
