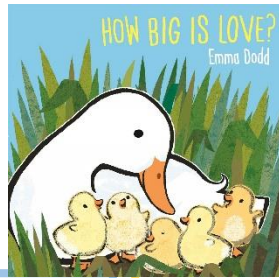


What are we learning in Reception this week?

Mathematics

Re-group the 'whole' using our knowledge and understanding of subitising. This means that for a given number i.e. 6 (whole), you can identify its parts... 3 and 3 or 2 and 4.

This will help to secure the children's understanding that the 'whole' is made up of smaller 'parts' and the whole remains the same.

Communication, Language and Literacy
